

ORGONE EARTH PIPES



Earth pipes are meant to be gifted completely underground. Bury the EP directly straight downward (perpendicular to the ground), similar to burying a tent stake, with the taped side facing the top (upward toward the sky). The open end with the black orgonite mix should be aimed directly downward into the Earth. EPs should be completely buried until they disappear (typically at least 2 to 3 inches below the surface of the ground). Depending on the location, use a hammer and smack the pipe until it disappears below the ground. If necessary, use a shovel to dig a hole first, then bury the EP, then fill in hole until the pipe disappears. In softer soil, a hammer will generally suffice. For rocky or hard soil, use a shovel or even a power drill with a large drill bit to loosen the soil before burying the EP with the hammer.

*Please observe caution and use common sense when planting earth pipes in the ground, and be mindful of potential obstructions below the ground.

In some cases, you may camouflage the EP by lifting a patch of soil/grass first, and then bury the pipe 2 to 3 inches below the ground, and then replace the patch of soil/grass over the buried pipe. In some cases, it helps to pour water over the patch to seal the soil and fuse the patch back to the ground so the grass/greenery may continue to grow as normal, while appearing undisturbed. The general rule for earth pipes is to bury them so that as much of the copper metal as possible makes direct contact with the earth, ground, and soil.
